## Making Us Safer Through Awareness

Safety Bingo Officially began at Paul Mueller Company on Monday, April 1, 2019. Every Paul Mueller Company employee is given a Bingo card and a Bingo dauber. It is your responsibility to keep track of your Bingo card. Lost cards will not be replaced; however, you will receive a new card on the next game.

The Bingo Jackpot is built by \$10 being added to it each day. The current game stops by either a person getting a "Bingo" or when a Recordable Injury has occurred. In the event of a Recordable injury, the game stops and the pot is forfeited. The new game will not start again until the incident has had time for review and discussion. If a game stops because we have a winner, a new Bingo game will begin the next day.

Bingo numbers are drawn seven days a week and are posted at 9:00 a.m. on: [employee.paulmueller.com](http://employee.paulmueller.com), Paul Mueller Company Employee Facebook page, digital displays, interactive time clocks, and by email.

When a person(s) win(s) a Bingo game, they have until the next ball is announced to claim their prize. They may email [bsafe@paulmueller.com](mailto:bsafe@paulmueller.com) or contact someone on the Safety Activities Committee. The last ball drawn must be part of the Bingo. In the event of multiple winners on the same jackpot, the prize amount will be evenly divided.

No taxes will be withheld directly from the winnings. Your winnings amount will be noted on your next paycheck voucher with the appropriate deductions calculated. This is an IRS rule that we have no control over.
